TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOU CAN USE

Select one or more of the following types of questions:

Multiple Choice (no more than 4 answer choices)

True or False

Fill in the Blank

Short Answer

Matching (no more than five things to match)

MAKE A KEY

Identify the correct answers for each question.

For short answer responses, provide key words that should be in the response.

DOUBLE CHECK YOUR WORK

Are your questions clear?

Are your questions challenging without being impossible to answer correctly?

Is there only one right answer for each question?

Is your answer key complete?

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
